Renewable Energy and Power Generation Business Prospects

Renewable Energy and Power Generation is growing sector in Indonesia as President Joko 'Jokowi' Widodo has set a goal of having renewable energy account for 23% of Indonesia's energy mix for electricity and transportation by 2025. This goal is part of Indonesia's 2016-2025 Electricity Supply Business Plan. The government plans to build 35,000MW power plants and according to its blueprint 62% will be produced by independent power producers (IPPs) while the remaining 38% is to be generated by the State Electricity Company (PLN).
